
ORDER

1. The present application has been filed for transfer of the case titled Ranjeet Singh & Ors V/S Satpaul Singh & Ors. from the court of Tehsildar Bishnah to any other competent court.
2. The case came up for hearing. Both the parties along with counsel present. They are heard. Para wise reply received from the court below is perused. During arguments, it has been brought in the notice of this court that the officer of the court below has been transferred and the transfer application has become infructuous.
3. I have heard the parties. From the office Record it has been found that Tehsildar Bishnah from whom the transfer of case has been sought has been transferred vide Govt. order 64 Revenue (Gaz) of 2017 dated 07-03-2017 & new incumbent has joined rendering transfer application infructuous & the same thus deserves to be dismissed on this ground.
4. Therefore, in view of the above, the transfer application, being infructuous, is hereby dismissed.

A copy of this order be sent to Tehsildar Bishnah for information & further necessary action.

Stay issued, if any, shall stand vacated. The case file be consigned to records after due completion.
