Revision petition u/s 15 of the Land Revenue Act against the order of Tehsildar, Jammu North dated 23-02-2021 bearing No. TJA/OQ/20-21/1209-1210 and quashing the order for demarcating the private land of the petitioners under Khasra No. 192, 193 & 194.

## ORDER

26.02.2021. This revision petition has been presented by the Learned Counsel for petitioner after being transferred to this Court by Learned Divisional Commissioner Jammu vide order dated 26-02-2021. Learned Counsel for the petitioners argued the matter and pressed for admission of the case and also to grant interim relief. While going through the record available with the case file and from the arguments advanced by Learned Counsel for the petitioner it is inferred that the present revision petition is premature and the Tehsildar has not passed any final order in the matter. However, as per the version of the Learned Counsel the parties are co-sharer and the petitioners have apprehension that the respondents may succeed in getting more land than their share. He further stated that their father had already during his lifetime apportioned the shares and put them to possession and accordingly the same is continuously under the peaceful possession of the parties.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is disposed off with a direction to the Tehsildar Jammu North to initiate proceedings under section 94 & 95 of J&K Land Revenue Act and decide the matter strictly under law within stipulated time and in presence of all the interested persons as and when the parties move application for partition. The file of SDM, if any, shall also go to Tehsildar to facilitate the process of partition proceedings. After completing the formalities of the partition proceedings, this Court be posted with compliance report. A copy of this order be sent to SDM proceedings, this Court be posted with compliance report. A copy of this order be sent to SDM Jammu North for necessary action. The case file be consigned to records after due completion.
