**Minutes of the Meeting held on 02.11.2021 at 6:00 pm under the Chairmanship of Dr. Raghav Langer, IAS, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu in his office chamber regarding WP (C) No. 1062/2020 C/w WP (C) No. 3187/2019 titled Suman Bansal V/s UT of J&K and Ors and CCP (S) No. 778/2019- constitution of Committee thereof.**

At the outset the Chairman welcomed the participants in the meeting and sought progress in the matter from the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Kathua (Chairman, Demarcation Committee) who informed the Chair that pursuant to the order No: DIVCOMM(J) of 2021 dated: 23.04.2021 issued by the Office of Divisional Commissioner, Jammu the committee held various meetings and visited the spot with regard to demarcation of land measuring 32 kanals situated at village Sunjwan and even effort was made to peruse the record of various Organizations and further informed the Chair that Aks-Latha and Massavi of khasra no 883 of village Sunjwan, Tehsil Bahu, District Jammu is required for proper demarcation of the land which has not been made available to the committee. After detailed deliberation, the chair issued following directions:

1. Deputy Commissioner, Jammu shall try to trace out and provide the report of Commission constituted in the year 2010 for demarcation of the land in which

Khasra No. 883 of village Sunjwan was also the subject matter to the committee.

2. Divisional Forest Officer, Jammu was directed to provide, if available, the digitized map and other details of the area to be demarcated to the Demarcation Committee.
3. Regional Director, Survey & Land Records, Jammu was directed to provide the relevant record, to the extent possible, to the Demarcation Committee.
4. Vice Chairman, Jammu Development Authority shall provide the Massavi/ Maps of khasra numbers of the adjoining stretches in the village Sunjwan to the Demarcation Committee, as mentioned in the report of the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Kathua.
5. Secretary, JMC (Addl. Charge ACR, JMC) was directed to provide the record pertaining to and relevant in the instant matter to the Demarcation Committee, as mentioned in the report of the ADC, Kathua
6. The Chairman Demarcation Committee shall inform the progress in the instant matter after two weeks for further appraisal and consideration of the Authorities. Meanwhile, the preliminary report of the Demarcation Committee shall be shared with all concerned officials.


The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
